We are seeking participants to take part in a research interview about their views on sentencing of sexual offences and their experiences of related criminal justice processes and support.

The study will be conducted by researchers at the University of Glasgow, and it is funded by the Scottish Courts and Tribunals Service. Findings will help inform Scottish Sentencing Council guidelines on the sentencing of sexual offences and best practice in relation to supporting survivors.

Participants must be survivors aged 18 years or over who have gone to court in a rape or sexual assault case in Scotland where there has been a conviction and sentence between 2018 - 2023.

Interviews will be confidential, and they can take place online or in-person at time that is convenient for you.
